The ceramics from **El Mojón** are renowned all over the island, and some of its charming figures, such as “Los Novios de El Mojón” (The Bride and Groom of El Mojón) are particularly famous. Apart from its ceramics, the people of El Mojón dedicate their days to grazing livestock and growing the traditional produce of Lanzarote, such as onions, potatoes and tomatoes, amongst other things. The village’s chapel of San Sebastián (16th century) is extremely pretty, despite its small dimensions, and features a single nave and a gable roof.
